Dear Residents,

As an update to you and particularly the residents of the Park Street area, the County will begin the street repair work on Park Street beginning October 20th. The work is expected to last approximately four (4) days, Monday through Thursday and, if necessary, they will use Friday to finish minor details.

The County Officials have assured us that the residents in and around the Park Street area such as Park Street Hamlet, KingsGate Condominiums and Park Street Apartments will have access to their property, but you may experience some delays. Residents on the Hilltop side of Park Street may also experience some delays.

Some upcoming events to look forward to include:

1) The Annual Halloween Parade will be held on Sunday, October 26th beginning at 2:00 PM.

2) The Annual Train Show at Old City Hall will begin on Friday, November 28th and continue through the weekend along with the Holiday Tree Lighting festivities. The Train Show will be open that weekend for viewing from 12 Noon until 8:00 PM on Friday, Saturday and Sunday and then every weekend during the month of December from 4:00 to 8:00 PM. Look for more information to be made available as we move closer to the holidays.

3) Preparations are beginning for the Holiday Tree Lighting and festivities for Thanksgiving Weekend and up to and including Christmas. Look for more information to be forthcoming for all the events and happenings around the City.

Other items of interest to the City residents are the receipt of a \$100,000 grant from the Delaware Valley Regional Planning Commission for planning purposes for the redevelopment of the Park, Ann and Third Street area and a Burlington County Parks Grant in the amount of \$81,800 to complete the Lime Kiln Alley and Flynn/Hilltop Parks.
