## 2021 DOG LICENSING NOTICE



Dog owners are required to obtain 2021 licenses no later than **January 31, 2021**. Licenses may be obtained at City Hall, 324 Farnsworth Avenue, during the hours of 9:00 AM and 4:00 PM. Owners of dogs who do not obtain licenses are subject to fines up to \$1,000, imprisonment for up to 90 days or community service for up to 90 days, or any combination thereof.

City Hall is currently open to the Public, however, COVID-19 restrictions are in place: facial mask covering must be worn, social distancing must be observed and hand sanitizer must be used prior to completing any transactions.

**ACCORDING TO STATE REGULATIONS, YOUR PET'S  
RABIES VACCINATION MUST NOT EXPIRE PRIOR TO THE  
END OF THE LICENSING YEAR.**

Certificate of rabies vaccination is required when purchasing your dog's license. If your pet has been spayed or neutered, this certificate must also be presented at the time of the issuance of the license.

Licenses purchased after January 31 will be subject to a \$5.00 late fee.
