Bordentown City – Public Property, Streets, and Water

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1. Roadways

- a. West Street:
 - i. Water portion of the project is complete.
 - ii. Flyers were handed out this week informing residents about the second phase of the project (roadway and concrete work). This will be starting within the next week.
- b. Oliver Street: Survey starts in early August and city will be organizing a community outreach effort afterwards (time/date tbd) to talk about our next infrastructure (road and water) project.

2. Projects

- a. Hankins Alley: Engineer will have preliminary design done shortly
- b. Parks: Capital budget allocated funds for several significant upgrades including playground equipment.
- c. OTP Parking Lot: City recently approved a contract to the lowest responsible bidder. Construction will start later this summer.

3. Water Department

- a. City returned to compliance with its water testing
- b. Asset Management Plan (AMP): Water capital budget includes several projects including meter replacements and well upgrades. Design will start this summer.
- c. The City remains committed to providing safe, reliable, lead-free water to its residents.
- d. We are also continuing the program of free lead testing to any resident who requests it.
