

June 29, 2020 Update (Special Meeting)

Bordentown City – Public Property, Streets, and Water

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1. Roadways
  - a. West Street: Construction for the water improvements started. Main installation is complete, and contractor is working on lateral services.
    - i. City is working with the contractor to replace homeowner-owned galvanized service lines at no cost to residents
    - ii. City will be looking to award a low bid construction contract for the remaining portion of West Street later this summer.
  - b. New Grant Opportunity with NJDOT
2. Projects
  - a. Pedestrian safety:
    - i. New sidewalk in front of Consolidated on Crosswicks: Construction is done, working on lunch list.
    - ii. Repave city parking lot (near OTP): I will be presenting an award of contract to a low bidder to repave this parking lot later this summer.
3. Water Department
  - a. Water's Consumer Confidence Reports (CCR) will be mailed out to all residents within the next two weeks
  - b. Compliance sampling is underway and due to state by the end of June.
    - i. Initial results are very positive
  - c. The City remains committed to providing safe, reliable, lead-free water to its residents, that minimizes the dissolving of lead from residential piping and faucets. We are also continuing the program of free lead testing to any resident who requests it, and we are verifying the service line materials at many of the homes with exceedances
4. Misc:
  - a. Summer maintenance: DPW is cutting and edging grass
  - b. Chestnut Ave flooding: City met with NJDOT Commissioner and staff in early June
  - c. City researching a grant opportunity for an electronic vehicle charging station
