2022 DOG LICENSING NOTICE

Dog owners are required to obtain 2022 licenses no later than **January 31, 2022**. Licenses may be obtained at City Hall, 324 Farnsworth Avenue, during the hours of 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM. Owners of dogs who do not obtain licenses are subject to fines up to \$1,000, imprisonment for up to 90 days or community service for up to 90 days, or any combination thereof.

City Hall is open to the Public; however, facial coverings must be worn while inside the building and it is recommended that you use the hand sanitizer that is available to you prior to completing any transactions.

ACCORDING TO STATE REGULATIONS, YOUR PET'S RABIES VACCINATION MUST NOT EXPIRE PRIOR TO THE END OF THE LICENSING YEAR.

Bordentown City Residents Only

1. A current certificate of rabies vaccination is required when purchasing your dog's license.
2. If your pet has been spayed or neutered and you are purchasing a **NEW** license, proof must be provided at the time of the issuance.
3. If you have licensed your pet previously and are **RENEWING** the license, you do not need to submit this information.
4. The License Application can be found on the City website.

Licenses purchased after January 31 will be subject to a \$5.00 late fee.
